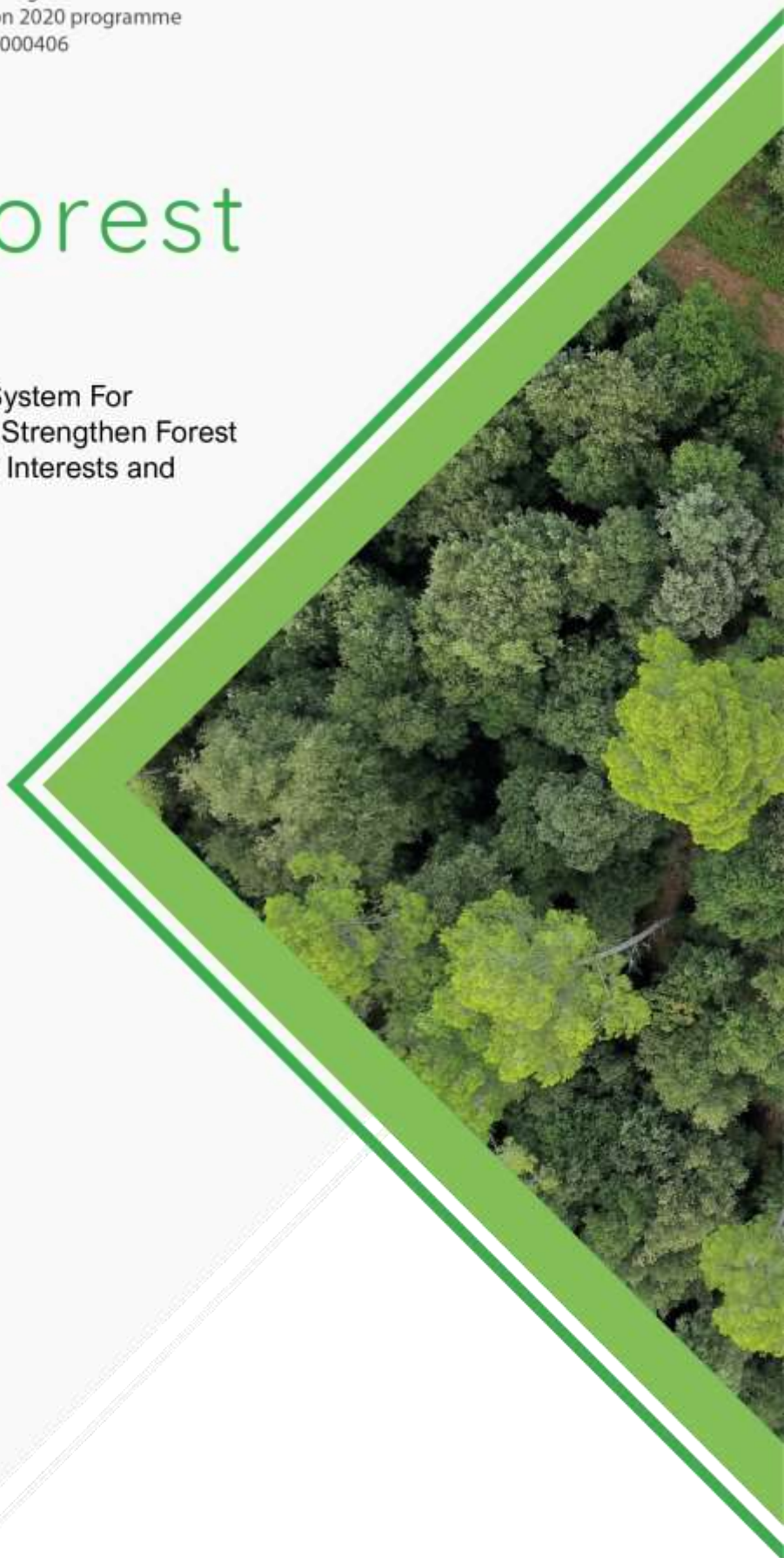

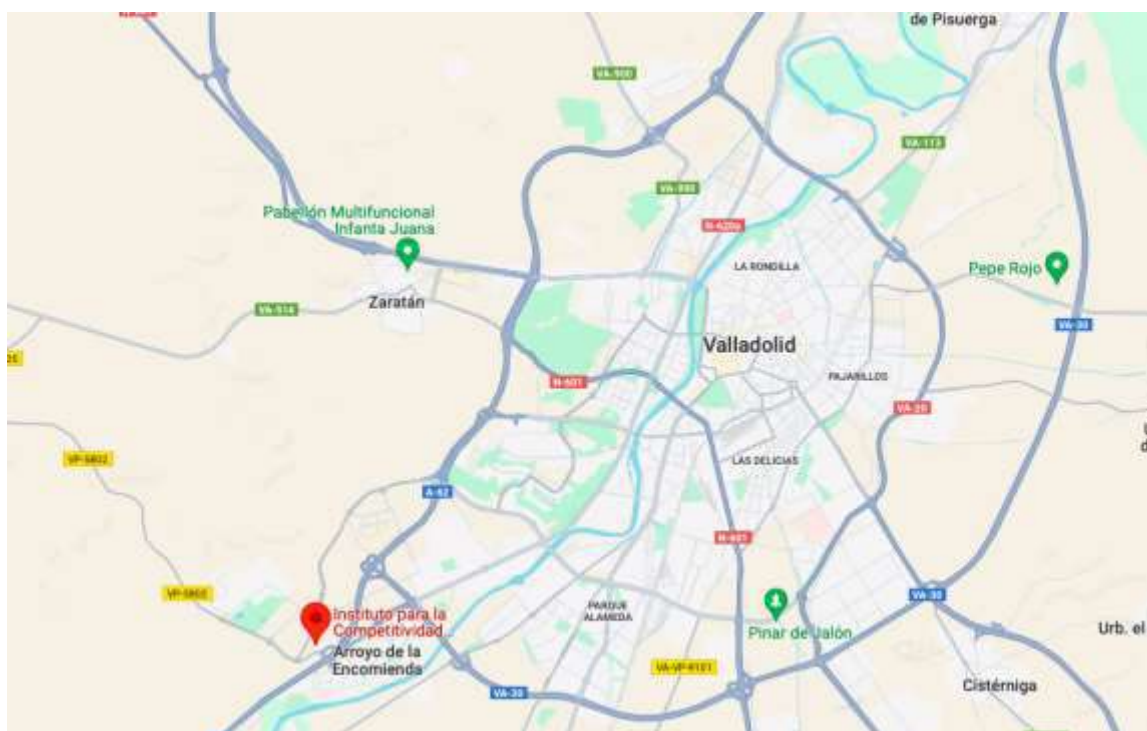

## Transportation

Valladolid enjoys a privileged geographical position, only 50 minutes from Madrid by train and just over two hours by car from the coast, with quality infrastructures such as the high-speed railway line, motorways and its own airport.



### By road

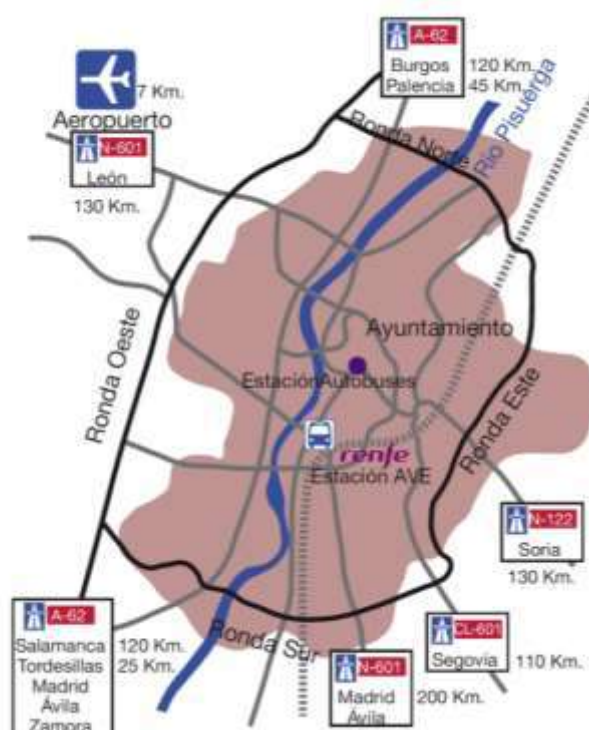
Valladolid is easily accessible by road from any part of the country, thanks to a solid network of motorways such as the A-6, which allows you to reach Madrid in two hours.

### By train

The Spanish High Speed Train (AVE) allows you to get to Valladolid from Madrid (Chamartin train station) in only 50 minutes!

Thanks to the “Avant” service, you can travel from Madrid at almost any time of day: it offers 27 daily services in both directions and 14 at weekends.

## Airports

The best connection is from the Madrid (Barajas) Airport.

Valladolid Airport, located in the neighboring town of Villanubla, has domestic flights from/to Barcelona - El Prat.

The bus ride from the airport to the center of Valladolid takes about twenty-five minutes. Buses pass through the airport approximately every 90 minutes, between eight in the morning and nine in the evening. Check the fares and timetables for the [Valladolid-Airport](#).
