Transportation

Valladolid enjoys a privileged geographical position, only 50 minutes from Madrid by train and just over two hours by car from the coast, with quality infrastructures such as the highspeed railway line, motorways and its own airport.



By road


Valladolid is easily accessible by road from any part of the country, thanks to a solid network of motorways such as the A-6, which allows you to reach Madrid in two hours.

By train

The Spanish High Speed Train (AVE) allows you to get to Madrid in just 50 minutes! This magnificent connection allows you to travel the Valladolid-Seville, Valladolid-Alicante or Valladolid-Barcelona routes in around four hours. From Valencia and Cordoba it will take you half an hour less.

What's more, thanks to the Avant service, you can travel from Madrid at almost any time of day: it offers 27 daily services in both directions and 14 at weekends.

Airports

Valladolid Airport, located in the neighboring town of Villanubla, has domestic flights to Barcelona - El Prat, an unbeatable connection to almost 200 destinations around the world.

The bus ride from the airport to the center of Valladolid takes about twenty-five minutes. Buses pass through the airport approximately every 90 minutes, between eight in the morning and nine in the evening. Check the fares and timetables for the Valladolid-Airport.

The airport also has an urban cab rank that applies a single fare for services to or from the city center. You can also rent a car to move around Valladolid with total comfort: within the airport itself you will find car rental offices.
