Venue location and dates

The General Assembly will take place in Padua city centre from the 3rd of June, 9:00 am, until Friday 5th of June at 12.00 pm. The meeting will be at the Centro Universitario Padovano, located in via Zabarella 82 (<https://www.centrouniversitariopd.it>).

Registration and Wi-Fi:

Registration: participants will be able to register from 8:00 am of the 3rd of June at the venue.

Wi-Fi will be provided free of charge after registration.

How to get to Padua if you arrive by plane:

Please note that **June 2nd** is a national holiday in Italy; therefore, trains and buses will operate on a **holiday schedule**.

The nearest airports are those of Venice “Marco Polo” and Treviso “Canova”.

(look for regional trains, it will require to change train in Venezia Mestre). The train trip lasts from 40 minutes up to 1 hour depending on the regional train.

Padua train station:

The train station is a 15-minute walk from the city centre. High-speed trains connect Padua with all major Italian cities.

The train station is served by most urban bus lines.

How to move around in Padua:

Padua city centre is a limited traffic zone, so we recommend moving around on foot or by bike. The tram and buses are also available, and you can pay for the tram directly with a credit card. While the tram is usually punctual, buses can be delayed during peak hours. For bus travel, we advise buying tickets in advance at a "Tabacchino" or a bar, as they are the primary sellers.
