How to get to the location of the meeting

FROM BUCHAREST AIRPORT

Brasov is located in central Romania and can be reached by train (2h30 min from Bucharest North train station). *Henri Coandă* Otopeni international airport is the largest and the closest international airport, which is located 12 km north of Bucharest. There is a direct train from the international airport to Bucharest North train station.

AIRPORT SHUTTLE FROM THE AIRPORT TO BRASOV

The transfer from *Henri Coandă* Otopeni international airport to Brasov can also be done by airport shuttle. They can pick you up at the airport and drop you in front of your hotel in Brasov. There are airport shuttles about each half hour, but the seat must be booked a couple of days before the flight (Transfer Brasov Otopeni, www.transferdirect.ro, Transfer aeroport, www.direct-aeroport.ro, M&M

Where to sleep?

The venue of the conference (Rectorate building of the Transilvania University of Brasov, Bd Eroilor no. 29) is close to the centre of Brasov, a very popular city with numerous hotels. Here are a few hotels you might be interested in: Hotel Armatti (0.3 km from venue) and Hotel Aro Palace (0.2 km from venue).

Currency

Romania's currency is Leu (plural "Lei" - pronunciation: *lay*). Common Abbreviation: RON

Banknote denominations: 1, 5, 10, 20, 50, 100 and 500 lei (all banknotes are printed on polymer)

Coins: 1, 5, 10 and 50 bani pieces.(pronunciation: bahnee)

1 leu = 100 bani

Foreign currencies may be exchanged at banks or authorized exchange offices (called: "casa de schimb" or "birou de schimb valutar").
